Are my household cleaning products hazardous?

Read the labels carefully and look for the following words or phrases:

- Danger
- Keep out of reach of children
- Warning
- Toxic
- Caution
- Flammable or ignitable
- Harmful or fatal if swallowed
- Corrosive
- Avoid skin contact
- Poison

Management of Household cleaning products

- Read labels before purchasing and avoid buying hazardous products whenever possible;
- Buy only the amount you'll be able to use;
- Read and follow all label direction for the product and disposal of the empty container;
- **DO NOT MIX CHEMICALS**
- Never dispose of chemicals on ground or in a septic system

Disposal of Hazardous cleaners / chemicals

- Use up all of product according to the directions or give away to friend or neighbor.
- **If any of the words or phrases that are listed at the top of the page, those are considered hazardous and should be taken to the Regional Collection Center for disposal. Call 563-589-1720 to schedule an appointment.**
