- Pesticide and chemical containers
- Syringes
- Car parts and oil filters
- Batteries

Plastic

- Prescription pill bottles
- Styrofoam
- Plastic bags and film wrap
- Plastic with a #6 symbol
- Plastic without a recycling symbol
- Oil and antifreeze containers
- Medical supplies and sharps

Glass

- Glass should be placed in the trash. Deposit containers should be returned to the distributors.

- Bleach and detergent containers
- Household cleaning containers

Metal

- Aluminum
- Tin, steel, and aluminum cans
- Metal jar lids
- Pots and pans

Paper Products

- Newspapers
- Magazines and catalogs
- Corrugated cardboard (staples ok)
- Grey chipboard
- Cereal boxes
- Cracker boxes
- Shoe boxes
- Junk mail and envelopes
