- Junk mail and envelopes
- Paper bags
- Mixed office paper
- Phone books
- Paper egg cartons
- Paperback books
- Paper towel and tissue roll cores
- Shredded paper strips



### Metal

- Aluminum
- Tin, steel, and aluminum cans

- #1 through #5 & #7 ONLY

## Education Office

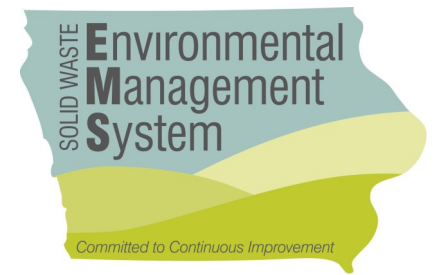
The Solid Waste Education Office is a partnership between DMASWA and Loras College. The office provides environmental information for educators and the general public.

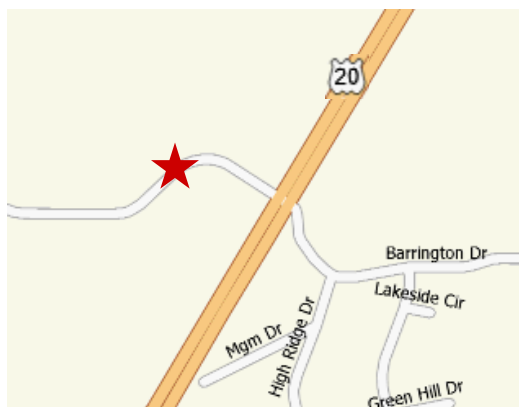

## Disposal Fees

Effective July 1, 2017

Solid Waste.....	\$45.00 per ton
Yard Debris.....	\$29.00 per ton
Solid Waste & Yard Debris Minimum ...\$15.00 per vehicle	
Solid Waste Minimum Charge	
Car.....	\$12.00 per vehicle
Special Waste.....	\$90.00 per ton
Asbestos ...Call for appointment & fees	
Shingle Recycling.....	\$29.00 per ton
Appliances.....	\$10.00 each
Electronics (Monitors, TVs, laptops) .....	\$15.00 each
All other electronics.....	no charge
Passenger Tires – unmounted (limit 4) .....	\$4.00 each
All Other Tires.....	\$250.00 per ton

## Other Materials Accepted

**Appliances:** All refrigerators, freezers, and microwaves must be empty and clean.

**Electronics:** Must be recycled. Monitors, laptops and TVs for a fee. All other electronics no charge.

**Asbestos:** Call ahead for an appointment, fee schedule, and disposal instructions.

**Yard Waste:** Leaves, garden trimmings, and brush are accepted for a fee.

**Shingle Recycling:** Loads of residential shingles can be recycled and will receive a discount.

## Household Hazardous Materials

Household hazardous materials can be dangerous to you and others if placed in the garbage or poured down a drain. Be safe at home. Bring in unwanted, unused, or unnecessary chemicals for proper disposal or recycling.

Businesses should call for an appointment.

Some of the items in your house or garage that are hazardous:

- Auto Fluids (antifreeze, oil, brake fluid, etc.)
- Auto batteries
- Fungicide
- Glues
- Insect Spray
- Kitchen/bathroom cleaners (solvent based)
- Lighter fluid
- Mothballs
- Nail polish remover
- Oven cleaner
- Paint, paint thinner, stain, varnish, turpentine, etc.
- Pesticides/poisons
- Weed killer
- Wood filler
- Wood preservatives
